You will have your choice of projects to complete. Choose one of the projects below and complete for the first day of school.

□ **Design a game with academic bowl-type questions.**

- Mrs. Olinski chooses four sixth-graders to compete in the Academic Bowl. The team moves from success to another, finally winning the state championship in Albany, New York. What are some questions that were used in the Academic Bowl? Come up with at least 20 questions for your game, and rules on how to play the game. Make sure you have the answers for the questions. We will play the games the first week of school. Also, write a paragraph why you choose the game for your project.

□ **Produce a scrap book/treasure box with items that the Souls would cherish.**

- If you produce a scrapbook, the scrapbook must have at least **8** pages. Include items on each page that the Souls would have had throughout the book. The scrapbook must have a decorated cover. Also, write a paragraph why you choose the scrap book for your project.
