Sunday, January 30th @ 11:30 a.m.- Liturgy and Open House from 12:30-2:30 p.m.

- All families and guests are invited to attend this special Mass.
- Students (**Grade 2-8**) and faculty should meet 15 minutes before the start of Mass in the gym, in order to join the entry processional.
- Students are asked to wear their school uniform.
- After the entry processional, students will join their families for the remainder of the Mass.
- This event coincides with open registration for new families. Please help us to welcome our visitors to the school. As always, children should be accompanied by their parents.
- Students should first go to the church so they will know where their parents will be sitting and to leave their coats (weather permitting) before heading to the gym to line up for the procession.
