

Summer Reading Grade One



Children entering Grade One in the fall are required to read a total of 10 books during the summer. A list of suggested titles and/or authors is attached. Any books by authors included on this list are recommended.

Students may read these books themselves if they have the ability to do so or their parents may read the books to them. Parent signatures are required to indicate that children have read each of the 10 books.

All entering first grade students are required to read If You Give a Mouse a Cookie by Laura Numeroff as one of the 10 selections. Students must draw a picture demonstrating their understanding of this story. A form for this drawing is attached. Students should bring this drawing together with their reading list to their classroom teacher on the first day of school.

Students who complete all of the requirements of the Summer Reading Program will receive a Reading Certificate indicating their participation and a pencil.
