

Summer Reading

Third Grade



Children entering Grade Three in the fall are required to read a total of three books. Everyone will read Charlotte's Web by E.B. White and The Bravest Dog Ever: the True Story of Balto by Natalie Stanford. These are the mandatory books. Students can then choose one other book from the list of suggested titles attached.

Students are required to keep a log of the three books they have read. A form for this purpose has been provided. Students will list the Author and Title of each of the books they read. A parent signature is required acknowledging that the student has read each of the books listed.

Students are required to do a book report ONLY on Charlotte's Web, demonstrating their understanding of the story. Fill out the story map form provided PRINT NEATLY. On the lines provided at the bottom of the form, write a sentence about something that happened at the beginning, middle, and end of the story. Draw a picture for each part in the space provided. (Please color)

Also please complete the "Fair Play" sheet for Charlotte's Web. Pay close attention to the "Extra" credit at the bottom of the page!
