There is now a medication consent form that needs to be completed and brought into school in order for any student to receive any medication while in school, this includes all over the counter medications such as Tylenol.

Any students who have life threatening allergies that may require the use of an Epi-pen must also have the emergency care plan paperwork filled out. This critical paperwork and the Epi-pen in its original packaging should be brought into school as soon as possible.
