Your assignments are due on the first day of school. Please be prepared to present your project to the class.

- Using the iPad application, *Puppet Pals*, create a skit from your favorite scene in the story. Your skit should be at least 2 minutes long and you should mention the characters' names, the setting, and the plot of your scene. Please share your video to Mrs. Shea at [mshoa@icsnewburyport.com](mailto:mshoa@icsnewburyport.com). The video should be shared through your Immaculate Conception School Google account that you use for computer class and for math games.
- Create a new book jacket. Your book jacket should include:
  - a. a colored illustration
  - b. the title and the author
  - c. a 3-5 sentence review of the book
  - d. a summary of the story
- Create a 3-slide Google Slides presentation. Each slide should include 4 sentences. Slide 1 should include the title and the author of the book. Slide 2 should describe your 2 favorite characters and why. Slide 3 should describe your favorite scene in the book. Feel free to use clip art to dress up your presentation. Please share your presentation with Mrs. Shea.
- Create a timeline demonstrating the sequence of events in the story. Please include at least 7 events. Include one sentence and an illustration for each event. Your timeline must include a heading with the book title and the author.

**Math**
